

Computer Technology Specialist: Green IT (Information Technology) Training Program

In some cases, information technology accounts for up to 50% of a company's energy costs



The ExecuTrain Green IT - Computer Technology Specialist Certification covers a wide range of entry to intermediate computer support skills. While it focuses on the knowledge required for computer support positions this program will also provide participants the basic knowledge required to assess a company's current IT systems structure and make recommendations to reduce the carbon footprint of the organization. Students will learn to build and trouble shoot a personal computer and at the end of the course, participants will take the computer with them and use it as a tool to continue to hone their computer support skills. Students successfully passing the post training Prometric assessment will achieve the International Business and Training Association's Certified Business Professional Certification in Computer Technology.
