

Windows SharePoint Services 3.0: Installation and Configuration

Description

This course is designed for IT administrators who need to install, configure, and maintain Windows SharePoint Services 3.0 on a Windows Server 2003 computer. It is intended as a quick start guide to assist in getting Windows SharePoint Services 3.0 up and running quickly on a Windows server.

Note: This course is *not* designed to teach user-level skills in SharePoint Services, administrative skills in Windows Server 2003, or SharePoint network planning and design.
